Who Can Participate?

Anyone who has **completed** the 6th grade is invited to participate in Work Camp. However, this is a very long, hard week for younger people. We expect them to work. You know your teens best. If you feel it would be better to wait until they have finished the 7th grade then use your discretion. Your group must meet the adult sponsor requirements listed below.

Adult Workers

Your group must include at least one adult for every five (5) teens. All adult sponsors and youth ministers will serve as crew leaders and must submit registration and medical forms.

Meals



Dinner on Sunday through Thursday will be provided by Work Camp, except for dinner on Tuesday. We will be having a night out-on-the-town. Breakfast will be served each morning on the campus, while lunches will be provided each day at area churches. Water, ice and cups will be provided at each site.

Crews

A work crew will consist of two to three (2-3) adults, including college students, and eight to ten (8-10) teens. All adults will serve as crew leaders.

Each youth group is divided up, and members are assigned to different crews. To help us, please pair your teens ahead of time on the back of the group registration form in the space provided. This will allow workers to make new friends, but be with at least one person they know while they work at the site during the day. **Changing groups will not be permitted.**

Tools

Each Work Camp participant is required to bring one four-inch paintbrush and a ladder. Paint, drop cloths, buckets, scrapers, etc. will be provided on site.



Transportation

It is **mandatory** that each group provide adequate transportation for the group they are bringing, plus an open trailer or truck in which to haul ladders and supplies. **All transportation vehicles brought to work camp will be used during the whole week to help transport volunteers.** It is imperative that you fill in the transportation worksheet completely.!

Advanced Preparation

As the youth leader, you should stress the seriousness of Work Camp. It is hard work; it is hot and humid. Everyone is expected to be a servant and work without complaining. You will be receiving some notes and outlines to help in teaching classes on servant hood, working together, etc., as you prepare your teens for Work Camp. It is recommended that you do a few smaller service projects before you come. Above all, pray for your teens and for Work Camp!



Registration

Registration costs this year are \$75 per teen and \$25 for youth ministers and other adult workers. A family discount will be given - \$50.00 per teen where there are 2 or more from one family. These charges cover lodging, meals, banquet and a T-shirt.



Please collect registration money from all participants by June 1. Then, mail **one church check** with the individual registration forms, medical forms, group registration and transportation form to:

Registration materials (**this includes all individual registration forms, medical forms, group registration form and payment**) must be postmarked **no later than June 1**. All forms are available at movworkcamp.org. A late fee of **\$25 per person** will be imposed on those who choose not to register by the deadline. This fee will also be imposed on forms that are not filled in completely. Because the number is limited to 500 this year, there is no guarantee that those who register late will be able to participate.
